DIVISION 01

Showmanship

Previous Winners – Previous winner of Senior Showmanship in past years.

Senior Showmanship – Ages 15 years and older as of January 1, 2026, and previous Intermediate Showmanship winners.

Intermediate Showmanship – Age 12 to 14 years old as of January 1, 2026, and previous Junior Showmanship Winners.

Junior Showmanship – Age 9 to 11 years old of current fair year.

Overall Showman – Winner of Senior, Intermediate and Junior Showmanship classes of this year.

DIVISION 02

Dairy Goats

1. Dairy Goats must be owned and pre-registered by June 15, 2026.
2. All dairy goats must have scrapie's ID Tag or legible tattoo upon arrival for check in on Saturday, August 1, 2026, and entered into online registration information
3. All dairy goats must have an official health certificate issued within 30 days of the fair or an Honor Herd certificate issued within the last year.
4. Females only.
5. No intact male animals will be allowed with the exception of: Goats - nursing kids under three months of age.
6. Nursing goat kids under three months old may be brought with mother. Chairperson must be notified by July 26, 2026.
7. Exhibitor may enter one animal per class.

DIVISION 03

Non-Dairy Breeding Stock Goats

1. Non-dairy goats must be owned and pre-registered by June 15, 2026.
2. All breeding goats must have a Scrapie ID Tag or legible tattoo upon arrival for check in on Saturday, August 1, 2026, and entered into online registration information.
3. Females only from non-dairy breeding stock.
4. All non-dairy breeding goats must have an official health certificate issued within 30 days of the fair or an Honor Herd certificate issued within the last year.
5. Exhibitor may enter one animal per class.

Class K03ND004: Grand, Reserve Champion, 3rd place Jr Non-Dairy Goat – Winners of Classes 01 thru 03

Class K03ND005: Non-Dairy Two-Year-Old Doe – Born August 1, 2023 – July 31, 2024

Class K03ND006: Non-Dairy Senior Doe – Born August 1, 2022 - July 31, 2023

Class K03ND007: Non-Dairy Mature Doe – Born before August 1, 2022

Class K03ND008: Grand, Reserve Champion, 3rd place Sr. Non-Dairy Goat – Winners of Classes 05 thru 07

Class K03ND009: Non-Dairy Goat Female of Show – Grand, Reserve Champion, 3rd, 4th 5th place Champion

DIVISION 04

Market Goats

1. Market Goats must be owned by April 25, 2026.
2. Market Goats must be brought to fairgrounds and ear tagged on Saturday, April 25, 2026, from 9 am until 11 am to be shown and sold at the 2026 fair.
3. All market goats must have a Scrapie ID Tag or legible tattoo upon arrival for check-in on Saturday, April 25, 2026. And entered into online registration.
4. All goats must be a female or castrated male.
5. It is recommended that market goats be born January 1, 2026 or later.
6. Market goats must weigh between 60 lbs and 110 lbs in order to sell at the fair.
7. Market Goats will be shown by divisions with a Grand, Reserve Champion selected for each division: Light Weight, Medium Weight, and Heavy Weight.

8. The Grand Champion and Reserve Champion of each division (3rd will be on standby) will return for the selection of the the Overall Grand & Reserve, 3rd, 4th, and 5th Champion Market Goat.

Class K04MG999 This class is for pre-registration purposes only. All market goats will need to pre-register prior to check in and register in this class. After weigh-in and class breaks are made, market goats will be placed in the appropriate weight classes.
